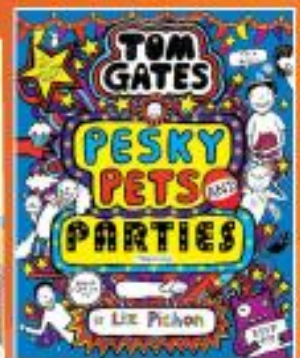
- School attendance this week is 93.6%. The class with the highest attendance was Stingrays with 97.5% attendance.
