We are pleased to announce that Old Town Infant School will be part of the Government's Free Breakfast Club scheme from September.

What is this?

All children (Reception to Year 2) will be able to access a free breakfast alongside 30 minutes of free childcare every morning.

This Government scheme is designed to help parents get their child to school on time and provide a healthy breakfast.

It is in line with the school's priority to support our pupils to have an excellent start to their day.

How will it work at Old Town?

Our breakfast club will open at **7.30am** for childcare and breakfast at a cost of £4 (this is a reduced rate considering the free session).

At **8.15am children can access the free session**. They will have access to a healthy breakfast and some activities before being taken to the classes at 8.45am.

All sessions must be pre-booked using the Arbor App. We are unable to take drop in arrivals on the day.

Both sessions will run from the hall.

When does it begin?

Breakfast club will be open from the first day of the Autumn Term (September) for both paid and free sessions.

Bookings for **both** sessions should be made in advance using your Arbor account. (Parents should select the session required.)
